1	20150822001	Soldier was operating his POV when he entered the opposing lane and overturned. Soldier was reportedly partially ejected and pronounced dead at the scene.
2	20150821001	Soldier reportedly lost control while operating a POV with a Soldier-passenger when the vehicle entered the opposing lane, striking an SUV. SPC-driver was reportedly not wearing his seatbelt and sustained fatal injuries as a result. PVT-passenger sustained critical injuries.
3	20150729001	Soldier was traveling in his POV when he crossed both lanes of the highway and collided head on with another vehicle that was approaching from the opposing lane. Soldier was evacuated for injuries where he passed from his injuries at 1850. Seatbelts-TBR
4	20150718001	A Soldier was driving a POV with another Soldier as a passenger when the vehicle crossed the center line and entered the opposing lane. The POV left the roadway, unto an upgrade, and came to rest in a culvert. The passenger died and driver received injuries. Seatbelts-Yes Alcohol/Drugs-TBR
5	20150707006	Two Soldiers were riding as passengers in the POV of one Soldier's mother, along with two other siblings, when she (the driver) lost control while changing lanes. The vehicle struck a guard rail and departed the road. The Soldier riding in the rear seat succumbed to his injuries. Seatbelts-TBD
6	20150706004	Soldiers were hunting on private property and were traveling in a POV/Pick-Up when it struck a pot-hole. Two Soldiers were thrown from the bed of truck, where they had been riding, and one sustained fatal injuries as a result. The 2nd Soldier sustained reportedly critical injuries. -- Alcohol/TBR
7	20150703002	Soldier was traveling west on the highway when a pick-up truck traveling east lost control and crossed the median into the westbound traffic where he collided with the Soldier`s vehicle. Soldier was pronounced deceased at the scene.
8	20150621001	Soldier was operating his POV on a state route when he reportedly failed to negotiate a curve. His vehicle proceeded off the road, into a culvert. Soldier was ejected from his vehicle and was pronounced dead at the scene by first responders. Alcohol-TBD, Seatbelt-Reported No.
9	20150531001	Soldier was proceeding on the interstate with his Spouse and child as passengers when they collided with a tractor-trailer that crossed the highway from the opposing lanes. Soldier and his family were fatally injured in the accident.
10	20150518021	Soldier was reportedly proceeding at a high rate of speed when his vehicle left the highway and impacted a tree. Soldier remained trapped in the vehicle when a post-crash fire ensued and was pronounced dead at the scene.
11	20150508001	Soldier was traveling at a high rate of speed when he lost control of his vehicle. The vehicle flipped and rolled almost 500 yards. Paramedics arrive on scene and pronounced the Soldier deceased. Seatbelts/Alcohol-TBD.
12	20150328001	Soldier was traveling north when he encountered a slight curve in the roadway. Soldier's vehicle crossed into the southbound lane and hit an oncoming Trans-Am ambulance. The Soldier was taken to the hospital where he was pronounced deceased.

13	20150315002	Soldier was operating his vehicle, reportedly at a high rate of speed, when he lost control and struck a concrete barrier. Soldier was wearing his seatbelt but was pronounced dead at the scene. Seatbelt-Yes; Alcohol/Drugs-TBD
14	20150308002	Soldier was presumably en route to his battle assembly location for duty when his vehicle impacted and proceeded over the guard rail from an exit ramp and entered a drainage canal. Soldier was pronounced dead at the scene. Alcohol/Seatbelts-TBD
15	20150228001	Soldier was the front passenger of a POV driven by a USMC when the vehicle rear ended a Semi-T/T that was stopped in the road. The Soldier and rear passenger (USMC) were ejected and sustained fatal injuries. Driver received minor injuries. No Seatbelts and Icy Road-Suspected; Alcohol-TBD
16	20150226003	Soldier was operating his POV in icy road conditions with reportedly minimal visibility when his vehicle crossed the median, entered the opposing lanes, and struck an approaching, fullyloaded cattle truck head on. -Soldier was pronounced dead at the scene. -Seat Belt use not yet reported.
17	20150219002	Soldier was driving a 2004 Pontiac GTO, reportedly on official business, when he exited onto an off ramp at a high rate of speed. He lost control of the vehicle, hit a tree, and became trapped inside of the vehicle. As a result, Soldier was pronounced deceased at the scene from his injuries.
18	20150128001	Soldier's vehicle reportedly crossed the center line and entered opposing traffic, colliding with a Semi-T/T. Soldier was pronounced dead at the scene
19	20150105001	Soldier was at his Transitional leave location when he was driving with his brother as his passenger. His vehicle went out of control on a curve and crashed and Soldier sustained fatal injuries as a result. Alcohol/Seatbelt/Speed-TBD
20	20150103001	Soldier was in a traffic accident en route to the airport during inclement weather to return to his duty station after holiday block leave. Soldier received multiple blunt force injuries during the crash sequence and was pronounced deceased at the scene. Seatbelts/Alcohol/Speed-TBD.
21	20141225001	Soldier was operating a POV when it crossed the median and crashed. He was pronounced dead at the scene by responding paramedics. AIT Soldier was on holiday block leave at his HOR at the time of the accident.
22	20141219001	Soldier is suspected of having lost control of his vehicle when it left the road, struck a pole, and came to rest in a pond. Soldier was discovered inside the vehicle. Speed is reported as causal by local authorities.
23	20141214001	Two Soldiers were en route to their Armory when they ran into icy roads and slid off the road, into a tree. A tree limb compromised the passenger side of the vehicle, fatally injuring the passenger. and seriously injuring the driver. Both Soldiers were wearing their seatbelts.
24	20141123003	Soldier and his female companion were involved in a head-on vehicle accident with a tractor trailer while traveling. Soldier and companion were both killed at the scene.
25	20141123001	Soldier reportedly lost control of his POV on a curve and spun while attempting to correct, striking a roadside tree with the rear of his vehicle. Soldier was reportedly wearing his seat belt but was pronounced dead following arrival at the ER.
26	20141108001	Soldier's vehicle reportedly drifted across the center line and collided with approaching vehicles. Soldier sustained fatal injuries and was pronounced dead at the scene;-Initial indications are that he was not wearing his seat belt.
27	20141102001	Soldier is reported to have been attempting to avoid a swerving vehicle when he lost control of his vehicle and struck a light pole. Soldier was wearing his seatbelt but was pronounced dead at the scene from injuries sustained in the impact
28	20141101001	Soldier was pulling out onto a Street (from a fast food restaurant) when his POV was struck on the driver-side by an approaching an SUV. Soldier-driver was pronounced dead at the scene

		and his PFC-passenger was treated and released for his injuries. Both Soldiers were wearing their seatbelts.
29	20141019003	Reserve Officer was en route back from his battle assembly location when his vehicle was reportedly rear-ended by a semi-T/T while stopped in traffic at a construction site. The Soldier was pronounced deceased on the scene.
30	20141014001	Soldier sustained fatal injuries in a single vehicle accident.
31	20141011001	Soldier was riding as a passenger in a vehicle driven by a civilian when their vehicle crossed the center line and struck another vehicle. Soldier was reported by authorities not to have been wearing his seatbelt and was pronounced dead at the scene.
32	20141004001	Soldier was riding as a passenger in a POV when the driver crossed over the centerline and collided head on with a POV truck. The Soldier was pronounced dead at the scene and the driver received serious injuries. The driver reportedly was intoxicated. Soldier was not wearing his seatbelt.
