SUBJECT: ASOC Prerequisite Waiver Request for CW2 John Doe

1. CW2 John Doe is scheduled to attend the Aviation Safety Officer Course (ASOC) in January 2005. Currently, he does not meet the 50-hour Pilot-in-Command (PC) requirement for attending the ASOC.
2. CW2 Doe was a UH-1H PC, with approximately 40 hours of PC time prior to his departure from the Sinai. I fully anticipate and expect him to return to PC status upon returning to the Sinai and accrue the remaining 10 hours within one (1) month.
3. I understand as does CW2 Doe that the term “waiver” in this instance does not negate his responsibility to complete the 50-hour PC requirement, but only allows him to attend and receive a certificate of completion. We likewise understand that he will not receive a graduation certificate, graduate in ATRRS, or receive the ASI/SQI until such time as you receive confirmation that he has completed the 50-hour PC requirement.
4. I have full faith and confidence in CW2 John Does’ ability to perform his duties as my Company Safety Officer. It is critical that CW2 Doe return to the MFO ASOC qualified in order to provide my 250-mile forward deployed platoon the direct safety over watch required in this extremely demanding flight environment. Therefore, I formally request a waiver for CW2 John Doe to the 50-hour Pilot-in-Command (PC) requirement for attending the Aviation Safety Officer Course (ASOC).
