

PMV-2 CRASH CLAIMS ONE SOLDIER'S LIFE

A Pennsylvania Army National Guard Soldier died from injuries sustained in a private motor vehicle (PMV-2) crash that occurred on 4 July 2014, at approximately 1145 local, in Midway, PA. The 22-year-old PFC was operating a late model Suzuki sport bike after departing his duty location formation when he crashed. The unit did not yet report the Soldier's licensing or training status. The Soldier was reportedly wearing a helmet. The PFC was pronounced deceased during air evacuation. [Local News Article](#) and [Obituary](#)

This is the **26th** Class A **PMV-2** (two-wheeled motor vehicles) fatality in FY14 compared to **22** for the same time frame in FY13.
