

# PMV-2 CRASH CLAIMS ONE SOLDIER'S LIFE

A 316<sup>th</sup> Cavalry Brigade, Fort Benning, Georgia, Soldier died from injuries sustained in a private motor vehicle (PMV-2) crash that occurred on 8 July 2014, at approximately 0830 local, in Columbus. The 27-year-old SPC was operating a 2007 Honda CBR1000RR motorcycle en route to his duty location when he left the roadway and crashed. He was found in the vicinity of a power pole by a passerby who attempted to revive him. He was wearing PPE and was licensed and trained. The SPC was pronounced deceased at a local medical center. This is the [27<sup>th</sup>](#) Class A **PMV-2** (two-wheeled motor vehicles) fatality in FY14 compared to **23** for the same time frame in FY13.
