

PMV-2 CRASH CLAIMS ONE SOLDIER'S LIFE

A 3rd Brigade Support Team, 101st Airborne Division, Fort Campbell, Kentucky, Soldier died from injuries sustained in a private motor vehicle (PMV-2) crash that occurred on 16 August 2014, at approximately 1330 local, in Dover, TN. The 47-year-old SSG was operating his Hayabusa Sport 1300cc motorcycle when he attempted to negotiate a curve, struck a guardrail, and was ejected. The Soldier was riding with another Soldier who called the paramedics. The SSG was pronounced deceased at a local medical center. The SSG was wearing PPE, was licensed, had completed the Motorcycle Safety Course, and was the battalion level PMV-2 mentor.

This is the [29th](#) Class A **PMV-2** (two-wheeled motor vehicles) fatality in FY14 compared to **30** for the same time frame in FY13. This PLR does not identify specific root causes of this incident as the investigation is ongoing. Further details will be available at a later date on RMIS (RMIS Login Required).
