

PMV-2 CRASH CLAIMS ONE SOLDIER'S LIFE

An 18th Military Brigade, Vicenza, Italy, Soldier died from injuries sustained in a private motor vehicle (PMV-2) crash that occurred on 6 September 2014, at approximately 0245 local, in Vicenza. The 26-year-old SPC was operating 2005 Honda CBR 600RR when he struck the rear end of a commercial truck. He was ejected from the motorcycle and was struck by a second vehicle while he was on the roadway. Soldier was pronounced dead at the scene. He was trained and wearing full PPE. [News Article](#)

This is the [31st](#) Class A **PMV-2** (two-wheeled motor vehicles) fatality in FY14 compared to **37** for the same time frame in FY13.
