

PMV-2 CRASH CLAIMS ONE SOLDIER'S LIFE

A Missouri Army National Guard Soldier died from injuries sustained in a private motor vehicle (PMV-2) crash that occurred on 28 September 2014, at approximately 0530 local, in Aurora, MO. The 59-year-old SGT was operating a 1992 Honda motorcycle en route to his drill location when he lost control on a curve and struck a tree. The Soldier was wearing a helmet and was pronounced dead at the scene. The Soldier was reportedly not licensed for motorcycles and had not taken the MSF Course. [News Article](#)

This is the [34rd](#) Class A **PMV-2** (two-wheeled motor vehicles) fatality in FY14 compared to **41** for the same time frame in FY13.
