

## PMV-4 CRASH CLAIMS ONE SOLDIER'S LIFE

A 10<sup>th</sup> Combat Aviation Brigade, Fort Drum, New York, Soldier died from injuries sustained in a PMV-4 crash that occurred on 14 October 2014 at approximately 0845 local in Stone Mills, NY. The 27-year-old SGT was driving a 2005 Pontiac Grand Am when he lost control, exited the side of the road, and drove into a farm field. The vehicle became entangled in an electric fence and overturned. The Soldier was ejected from the vehicle. The SGT was not wearing his seatbelt and was pronounced dead at the scene.

This is the [3<sup>rd</sup>](#) Class A PMV-4 (four-wheeled motor vehicles) fatality in FY15 compared to **0** for the same time frame in FY14. This PLR does not identify specific root causes of this incident as the investigation is ongoing. Further details will be available at a later date on RMIS (RMIS Login Required).
