

PMV-2 CRASH CLAIMS ONE SOLDIER'S LIFE

A 4th Brigade Combat Team, 1st Armored Division, Fort Bliss, Texas, Soldier died 17 October 2014 at 0930 local from injuries sustained in a private motor vehicle (PMV-2) crash that occurred on 16 October 2014, at approximately 1630 local, in El Paso. The 23-year-old SPC was operating his 2009 Suzuki GSXR 1000 motorcycle at a high rate of speed when he collided with a Hyundai Santa Fe as it was turning left into his path at an intersection. He was ejected from the motorcycle. The Soldier was wearing a helmet and had completed civilian MSF training but not the SBRC. He was pronounced dead after removal from life support. This is the 1st Class A **PMV-2** (two-wheeled motor vehicles) fatality in FY15 compared to 2 for the same time frame in FY14.
