

PMV-2 CRASH CLAIMS ONE SOLDIER'S LIFE

A 227th Aviation Regiment, 1st Cavalry Division, Fort Hood, Texas, Soldier died from injuries sustained in a private motor vehicle (PMV-2) crash that occurred on 19 October 2014, at approximately 1300 local, in Burnett County, Texas. The 33-year-old SSG was operating his 2004 Buell XB12R Sport motorcycle with another Soldier when he left the roadway and impacted a tree after having accelerated away from the other Soldier. The other Soldier-rider discovered him after the accident and called for assistance. He was evacuated to a hospital but later died from his injuries. The Soldier was wearing a helmet. The Soldier was licensed and trained. [News Article](#)

This is the 2nd Class A **PMV-2** (two-wheeled motor vehicles) fatality in FY15 compared to **2** for the same time frame in FY14.
