

PMV-2 CRASH CLAIMS ONE SOLDIER'S LIFE

A General Leonard Wood Army Community Hospital, Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri, Soldier on transitional leave died from injuries sustained in a private motor vehicle (PMV-2) crash that occurred on 7 November 2014, at approximately 1800 local, in Waynesville, MO. The 47-year-old SFC was operating his motorcycle when he was struck by a four-wheeled vehicle. The Soldier was wearing a helmet and was pronounced dead at the scene.

This is the 3rd Class A **PMV-2** (two-wheeled motor vehicles) fatality in FY15 compared to **4** for the same time frame in FY14. This PLR does not identify specific root causes of this incident as the investigation is ongoing. Further details will be available at a later date on RMIS (RMIS Login Required).
