

PEDESTRIAN MISHAP CLAIMS ONE DAC'S LIFE

On 26 November 2014, at approximately 0945 local, a Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri, Department of the Army Civilian was operating his POV on Fort Leonard Wood when he slid off the road in snow conditions and came to rest in the ditch. After he exited his vehicle, he was struck by an approaching vehicle and was pronounced dead at the General Leonard Wood Army Community Hospital Emergency Room. [Local News](#)

Leader Engagement Tips

- Remind your personnel that if road conditions have caused a vehicle to leave the road or become stranded, those same conditions will make it difficult for other drivers to avoid pedestrians attempting to assist or escape stranded vehicles

This is the **1st** Class A **Pedestrian Mishap** resulting in a DAC fatality in FY15 compared to **0** for the same time frame in FY14. This PLR does not identify specific root causes of this incident as the investigation is ongoing. Further details will be available at a later date on RMIS (RMIS Login Required).
