

# PMV-4 CRASH CLAIMS ONE SOLDIER'S LIFE

A 101<sup>st</sup> Support Brigade, Fort Campbell, Kentucky, Soldier died from injuries sustained in a PMV-4 crash that occurred on 28 January 2015 at approximately 1230 local in Clarksville, Tennessee. The 20-year-old PFC was operating a 2003 Chevrolet Cavalier when he crossed the center lane, entered oncoming traffic, and struck a semi-truck tractor trailer head on. The Soldier was wearing a seatbelt and was pronounced deceased at the scene. [News Article](#)

This is the [15<sup>th</sup>](#) Class A PMV-4 (four-wheeled motor vehicles) fatality in FY15 compared to **9** for the same time frame in FY14.
