

PMV-4 CRASH CLAIMS ONE SOLDIER'S LIFE

An 3rd Chemical Brigade, Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri, Soldier died from injuries sustained in a PMV-4 crash that occurred on 28 February 2015 at approximately 1600 local in Lebanon, MO. The PFC was riding as a passenger in a vehicle being driven by Fort Leonard Wood USMC Detachment Soldier when it collided with the rear-end of a semi-tractor-trailer that was stopped in the lane. Their vehicle lost traction on snow/ice while slowing for the semi that was stopped in response to an automobile crash that had occurred earlier. The Soldier and a second passenger, also a USMC member, sustained fatal injuries after being ejected from the vehicle. [News Article](#)

This is the [19th](#) Class A PMV-4 (four-wheeled motor vehicles) fatality in FY15 compared to **10** for the same time frame in FY14.
