

PMV-2 CRASH CLAIMS ONE SOLDIER'S LIFE

A 101st Airborne Division Artillery, Fort Campbell, Kentucky, Soldier died from injuries sustained in a PMV-2 (motorcycle) crash that occurred on 15 March 2015, at approximately 1840 local, in Clarksville, TN. The 28-year-old SGT was operating his motorcycle when he drifted across center line, and collided with an approaching vehicle. The Soldier was pronounced dead at the scene. He had completed MSF training and was wearing PPE. [Local News Article](#)

This is the 6th Class A **PMV-2** (two-wheeled motor vehicles) fatality in FY15 compared to **8** for the same time frame in FY14. This PLR does not identify specific root causes of this incident as the investigation is ongoing. Further details will be available at a later date on RMIS (RMIS Login Required).
