

# PMV-2 CRASH CLAIMS ONE SOLDIER'S LIFE

A Maryland Army National Guard Soldier died from injuries sustained in a PMV-2 (motorcycle) crash that occurred on 16 April 2015, at approximately 1615 local, in Baltimore. The 30-year-old SSG lost control of his Honda CBR700 motorcycle at an exit and impacted the guard rail. [Local News Article](#)

This is the [7<sup>th</sup>](#) Class A **PMV-2** (two-wheeled motor vehicles) fatality in FY15 compared to **12** for the same time frame in FY14.
