

PMV-4 CRASH CLAIMS ONE SOLDIER'S LIFE

An I Corps, 593rd Expeditionary Sustainment Command, Joint Base Lewis McChord, Washington, Soldier died while on transitional leave from injuries sustained in a PMV-4 crash that occurred on 31 May 2015 at approximately 1930 local east of Amarillo, Texas. The 24-year-old SGT, his wife, and their child were proceeding west on U.S. Interstate 40 in a 2015 Chevrolet Equinox when they collided with a tractor-trailer that crossed into their path from the eastbound lanes. This is the [24th](#) Class A PMV-4 (four-wheeled motor vehicles) fatality in FY15 compared to [22](#) for the same time frame in FY14.
