

# PMV-2 CRASH CLAIMS ONE SOLDIER'S LIFE

A 101<sup>st</sup> Combat Aviation Brigade, Fort Campbell, Kentucky, Soldier died from injuries sustained in a PMV-2 (motorcycle) crash that occurred on 13 June 2015, at approximately 0130 local, in Clarksville, TN. The 24-year-old PFC was riding a 2003 Honda C4 954 sport bike when he collided with another Soldier who was riding with him. Both Soldiers were injured and airlifted to a local medical center where he was pronounced deceased at 0600. He was wearing a helmet and had completed BRC. [News Article](#)

This is the 11<sup>th</sup> Class A **PMV-2** (two-wheeled motor vehicles) fatality in FY15 compared to **23** for the same time frame in FY14.
