

ARMY PRELIMINARY LOSS REPORT 15073 PMV-2 CRASH CLAIMS ONE SOLDIER'S LIFE

On 6 July 2015, at approximately 1900 local, a 325th Airborne Infantry Regiment, 2nd Brigade Combat Team, Fort Bragg, North Carolina, Soldier was involved in a PMV-2 (motorcycle) crash in Fayetteville. The 19-year-old PFC was operating his Yamaha R1 motorcycle with the right of way when he collided with a Toyota Tundra pickup truck that was making a left turn across his path. He was transported to a local medical center where he was pronounced deceased on 7 July 2015, at 0045. He completed the Motorcycle Safety Foundation Course. [News Article](#)

This is the 14th Class A **PMV-2** (two-wheeled motor vehicles) fatality in FY15 compared to **26** for the same time frame in FY14.
