

PEDESTRIAN MISHAP CLAIMS ONE SOLDIER'S LIFE

A Darnall Army Medical Center, Fort Hood, Texas, Soldier died in a pedestrian mishap that occurred on 25 May 2015, at approximately 0200 local, in Killeen. After leaving a night club, the 28-year-old SGT was struck by a hit-and-run vehicle while crossing a major boulevard, not at a crossing, and was assisted by a civilian responder. As she was rendering aid to the Soldier in the road, they were both struck by another vehicle. The Soldier was evacuated for injuries but subsequently died on 25 July 2015. As of 25 May 2015, this was the [9th](#) Class A **Pedestrian Mishap** resulting in a fatality in FY15 compared to **3** for the same time frame in FY14. This PLR does not identify specific root causes of this incident as the investigation is ongoing. Further details will be available at a later date through RMIS (RMIS Login Required).
