

PMV-2 CRASH CLAIMS ONE SOLDIER'S LIFE

On 13 August 2015, at approximately 1230 local, a 2nd Armored Brigade Combat Team, 4th Infantry Division, Fort Carson, Colorado, Soldier was involved in a PMV-2 (motorcycle) crash on Fort Carson. The 22-year-old SPC was operating his newly purchased CBR 600rrs sports bike when he lost control and was thrown into a roadside light pole. The Soldier was wearing all PPE had completed the basic rider training. He was pronounced dead in the emergency room on Fort Carson. [News Article](#)

This is the [20th](#) Class A **PMV-2** (two-wheeled motor vehicles) fatality in FY15 compared to **28** for the same time frame in FY14.
