

## PMV-4 CRASH CLAIMS ONE SOLDIER'S LIFE

A Combat Aviation Brigade, 1<sup>st</sup> Infantry Division, Fort Riley, Kansas, Soldier died from injuries sustained in a PMV-4 crash that occurred on 22 August 2015 at approximately 0230 local, in Worth County, Missouri. The 19-year-old PFC was operating his vehicle when he entered the opposing lane and overturned. The Soldier was partially ejected and was pronounced dead at the scene. [News Article](#)

This is the **32<sup>nd</sup>** Class A PMV-4 (four-wheeled motor vehicles) fatality in FY15 compared to **34** for the same time frame in FY14.
