PMV-2 Crash Claims One Soldier's Life

A Soldier assigned to the 1st Armored Brigade Combat Team, 1st Infantry Division, Fort Riley, KS, died of injuries from a PMV-2 crash that occurred on 7 July 2016, at approximately 1100 local, in the vicinity of Vinita, OK. The 20-year old PV2 was on leave when he was discovered unresponsive by authorities, after his motorcycle had left the road and struck a telephone pole. The Soldier was wearing a helmet and had completed motorcycle safety training in March 2016. Soldier also passed a safety check ride in June 2016, prior to his leave.

This is the **22nd** Class A, PMV-2 (two-wheeled motor vehicle) fatality in FY16, compared to **15** for the same time frame in FY15. This PLR does not identify specific root causes of this incident as the investigation is ongoing. Further details will be available at a later date through RMIS (RMIS Login Required).

PLR's are intended to alert leaders to mishaps resulting in the loss of Soldiers/Civilians and to provide awareness in the interest of prevention and combat readiness.
