## **PMV-2 Crash Claims One Soldier's Life**

A Soldier assigned to the 101<sup>st</sup> Airborne Division Artillery, Fort Campbell, KY, died of injuries from a PMV-2 crash that occurred on 2 July 2016, at approximately 0500 local, in Clarksville, TN. The 29-year old SGT was struck by an intoxicated motorist that turned in front of him at an intersection. The Soldier was pronounced deceased at the local medical center and the civilian pick-up operator was apprehended and cited for vehicular homicide.

This is the **23<sup>rd</sup>** Class A, PMV-2 (two-wheeled motor vehicle) fatality in FY16, compared to **14** for the same time frame in FY15. This PLR does not identify specific root causes of this incident as the investigation is ongoing. Further details will be available at a later date through RMIS (RMIS Login Required).

PLR's are intended to alert leaders to mishaps resulting in the loss of Soldiers/Civilians and to provide awareness in the interest of prevention and combat readiness.

Our Army depends on you to use these PLRs to help Soldiers understand the impact of decisions made on and off duty.
