NTV Mishap Claims One Soldier's Life

A USARCENT Soldier died as the result of an NTV mishap that occurred on 10 September 2016, at approximately 1300 local, in Kuwait. The 25-year old 1LT was transporting Soldiers in a 2013 Mitsubishi Pajero when it experienced a flat tire and overturned. He was ejected from the vehicle and was pronounced dead at the scene. The remaining three passengers sustained injuries, one of whom was evacuated.

This is the **1st** Class A, fatal AOV (Army Operated Vehicle) accident, compared to **2** for the same timeframe in FY15. This PLR does not identify specific root causes of this incident as the investigation is ongoing. Further details will be available at a later date on RMIS (RMIS Login Required).

PLRs are intended to alert leaders to mishaps resulting in the loss of Soldiers/Civilians and to provide awareness in the interest of prevention and combat readiness.
