PMV-2 Crash Claims One Soldier's Life

A Soldier assigned to the 5th Squadron of the 73rd Cavalry, 82nd Airborne Division, Fort Bragg, NC, died of injuries from a PMV-2 crash that occurred on 17 September 2016, at approximately 2100 local, in Raleigh, NC. The 23-year old SPC was proceeding through an intersection with the right-of-way when he collided with a vehicle that was turning in his path from the opposing lane. The Soldier attempted to avoid but struck the vehicle in the right, rear panel. He sustained serious injuries from which he died the following morning. His female passenger is expected to survive the crash. He was licensed, trained, and wearing full PPE at the time of the crash.

This is the 31st Class A, PMV-2 (two-wheeled motor vehicle) fatality in FY16, compared to **25** for the same time frame in FY15. This PLR does not identify specific root causes of this incident as the investigation is ongoing. Further details will be available at a later date through RMIS (RMIS Login Required).

PLRs are intended to alert leaders to mishaps resulting in the loss of Soldiers/Civilians and to provide awareness in the interest of prevention and combat readiness.
