PMV-4 Crash Claims One Soldier's Life

A 3rd Combat Aviation Brigade, 17th Cavalry Regiment, Fort Stewart, Georgia, Soldier died from injuries sustained in a PMV-4 crash that occurred on 11 October 2015 at approximately 1900 local, in Savannah. The 23-year-old SPC was driving at a high rate of speed when he lost control of his vehicle and it overturned. Local authorities reported that he was not wearing a seatbelt and was ejected from his vehicle. The Soldier was pronounced dead at a local medical center. [News Article](#)

This is the **2nd** Class A PMV-4 (four-wheeled motor vehicles) fatality in FY16 compared to **2** for the same time frame in FY15. This PLR does not identify specific root causes of this incident as the investigation is ongoing. Further details will be available at a later date through RMIS (RMIS Login Required).
