## **PMV-4 Crash Claims One Soldier's Life**

A DIVARTY, 3<sup>rd</sup> Infantry Division, Fort Stewart, Georgia, Soldier died from injuries sustained in a PMV-4 crash that occurred on 17 October 2015, while on leave at his home of record, in Haiti. The 38-year-old 1LT was riding as the front seat passenger of a family vehicle when it collided with another vehicle. The Soldier was pronounced dead at a local medical center. The other six occupants in the vehicle received non-life threatening injuries.

This is the **3<sup>rd</sup>** Class A PMV-4 (four-wheeled motor vehicles) fatality in FY16 compared to **3** for the same time frame in FY15. This PLR does not identify specific root causes of this incident as the investigation is ongoing. Further details will be available at a later date through RMIS (RMIS Login Required).
