PMV-2 Crash Claims One Soldier's Life

A 3rd Cavalry Regiment, Fort Hood, TX, Soldier died from injuries sustained in a PMV-2 crash that occurred on 3 December 2015, at approximately 1500 local. The SPC was operating his Honda CBR 600 sport bike when he attempted to pass an 18-wheeler as it was turning right at an intersection and struck the trailer broadside. The Soldier was licensed, trained, and was wearing proper PPE but was pronounced dead at the scene.

This is the 4th Class A PMV-2 (two-wheeled motor vehicles) fatality in FY16 compared to **3** for the same time frame in FY15. This PLR does not identify specific root causes of this incident as the investigation is ongoing. Further details will be available at a later date through RMIS (RMIS Login Required).
