## **PMV-2 Crash Claims One Soldier's Life**

A US Army Reserve Command Soldier died on 5 December 2015 from injuries sustained in a PMV-2 crash that occurred on 3 October 2015, at approximately 1225 local. The SSG was riding his cruiser-model motorcycle to his drill location from lunch when he lost control and crashed in Sanford, FL. The Soldier was licensed, trained, and was wearing proper PPE. Police report cited speed as too fast for road conditions.

As of 3 October 2105, this was the **1<sup>st</sup>** Class A PMV-2 (two-wheeled motor vehicles) fatality in FY16 compared to **0** for the same time frame in FY15. This PLR does not identify specific root causes of this incident as the investigation is ongoing. Further details will be available at a later date through RMIS (RMIS Login Required).

Preliminary Loss Reports (PLRs) are intended to alert leaders to mishaps resulting in the loss of Soldiers/Civilians and to provide awareness in the interest of prevention and combat readiness.
