


TYPE: Dual Engine Light Utility/MEDEVAC Helicopter
STANDARD CREW: 3 (Medical 4)
PASSENGERS: 6 (Medical 4)
LITTERS: 1 or 2



● The battery is in the compartment located in the right rear of the fuselage, just below the engine. To disconnect the battery, twist the release knob counterclockwise, then pull it away from the battery.

● Emergency entrance is gained through both pilot doors and/or passenger cabin doors. The pilot doors are not jettisonable. The passenger cabin doors slide to the rear. If the doors fail to open, release the red cover on the top of the cargo door window, pull tab until the window seal is completely removed, and remove Plexiglas to gain access.



WARNING:
In case of fire, the safest approach to the UH-72 is 45 degrees off the nose of the aircraft.
