No	Case Number	Description
1	20150921001	One Soldier was handling his loaded M9 weapon in the presence of other Soldiers who were playing pool when the weapon discharged. The round struck another Soldier in the abdomen and he later passed from his wound.
2	20150829001	Seven Soldiers from the unit were gathered at one Soldier's residence when a firearm discharged while being handled. One of the visiting Soldiers was struck in the head by a round and he died at the residence. Alcohol is reported as involved.
3	20150705001	An NCO (SSG) was handling the hand gun of another NCO (SGT), whose home he had been visiting, when it fired a round. The round struck the SSG in the head and he sustained fatal injuries as a result.
4	20150426016	Soldier was handing his weapon, demonstrating its use to another (visiting) Soldier, when it discharged a round that struck the handler in the head, resulting in fatal injury. Police investigation determined that the incident was accidental. The Soldier had a 0.27 BAC
