PMV-4 Mishap Claims One Soldier's Life

A Private assigned to 75th Field Artillery Brigade, Fort Sill, Oklahoma, died in a PMV-4 mishap 21 October 2017 in Apache, Oklahoma at 1000 local. The Soldier was operating a PMV-4 when it exited the roadway, struck a tree and caught fire. He was pronounced dead at the scene. Seat belt use is unknown.

ENGAGEMENT TIPS:

- Discuss weekend plans with your Soldiers and talk to them about the dangers of driving distracted, remind them to obey posted speed limits and recommend they travel with a battle buddy, if feasible.
