PMV-4 Mishap Claims One Soldier's Life

A Specialist assigned to the 10th Mountain Division, Fort Polk, Louisiana, died in a PMV-4 mishap 30 November 2017 at 2330 local in Leesville, Louisiana. The Soldier was a passenger in a vehicle, driven by another Soldier, that was reportedly traveling at a high rate of speed. The vehicle left the road and struck a tree, causing the Soldier to suffer fatal injuries. The driver incurred non-life-threatening injuries. Both Soldiers were wearing seat belts.
