PMV-2 Mishap Claims One Soldier's Life

A Staff Sergeant assigned to 25th Infantry Division, Schofield Barracks, Hawaii, died 14 December 2017 at 1930 local in Ewa Beach. The Soldier was operating a motorcycle when he was struck by another vehicle. He was transported to a local hospital, where he was later pronounced dead. He was licensed, wearing all required PPE and had completed Motorcycle Safety Foundation training.
