Army Motor Vehicle Mishap Claims One Soldier's Life

A Specialist assigned to the Florida Army National Guard died in an Army Motor Vehicle mishap 19 January 2018 in Sebring, Florida, at 1156 local.

The Soldier's unit was conducting a vehicle convoy from the Miramar Readiness Center to Avon Park Bombing Range when three M1120 LHS trucks were involved in a chain-reaction crash. Five other Soldiers were evacuated to local hospitals.
