PMV-2 Mishap Claims One Soldier's Life

A Staff Sergeant assigned to U.S. Army Special Operations Command, Joint Base Lewis-McChord, Washington, died in a PMV-2 mishap 19 May 2018 in Roy, Washington, at 1250 local. The Soldier was reportedly operating a motorcycle on a rural road when, after cresting a hill, he encountered two vehicles stopped in the roadway. The motorcycle rear ended one of the vehicles, resulting in the Soldier's fatal injuries. Speed was reported as a factor in the accident.
