PMV-4 Mishap Claims One Soldier's Life

A 50-year-old Active Guard Reserve Sergeant First Class assigned to the North Dakota Army National Guard died in a PMV-4 mishap 18 September 2018 near Devils Lake, North Dakota, at 1500 local. The Soldier was traveling on a two-lane road when his vehicle struck the rear of an 18-wheeled tractor-trailer that had slowed to make a left turn.
