A 21-year-old Private First Class assigned to U.S. Army Medical Research and Materiel Command, stationed at U.S. Army Natick Soldier RD&E Center, Massachusetts, died in a PMV-4 mishap 10 October 2018 in Natick, Massachusetts, at 2233 local. The Soldier was a passenger the vehicle when it crashed for unreported reasons and sustained heavy damage. The Specialist driving the vehicle was evacuated for his injuries.
