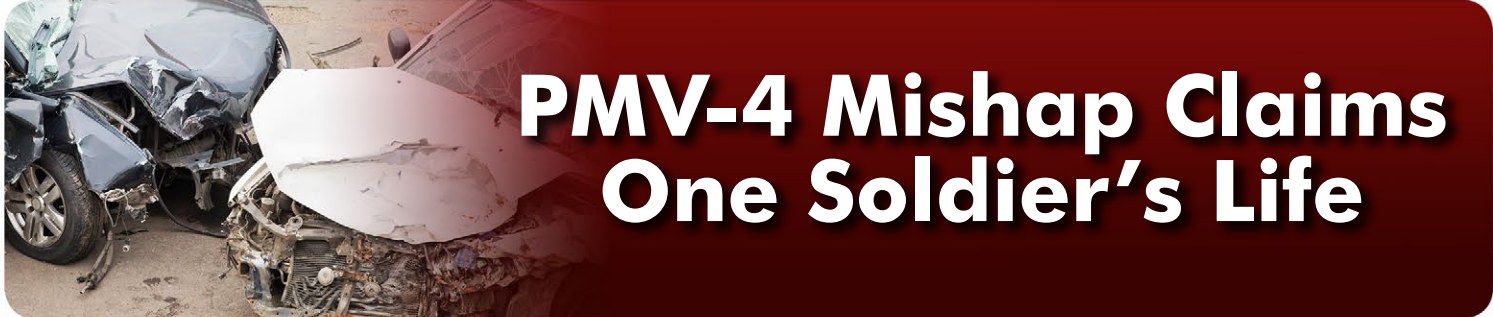

PMV-4 Mishap Claims One Soldier's Life

A 32-year-old Master Sergeant assigned to 101st Airborne Division (AA) died following a PMV-4 mishap 8 November 2018 in Missoula County, Montana, at 1956 local. The Soldier, while on PCS leave, was traveling on an interstate highway when he was involved in a mishap with another vehicle. He was reportedly not wearing his seat belt and thrown from his vehicle. The Soldier died from his injuries 10 days later.
