PMV-4 Mishap Claims One Soldier's Life

A 36-year-old Soldier stationed at Fort Carson, Colorado, died in a PMV-4 mishap 27 May 2019 in North Carolina at 2000 local. The Soldier was traveling on an interstate with three of his children when his Dodge Caravan struck a tow truck that was responding to a disabled motorist. The tow truck was reportedly partially in the left travel lane with its yellow flashing lights activated when the mishap occurred. The Soldier was pronounced dead at the scene, and two of his children suffered fatal injuries.
