Swimming Mishap Claims One Soldier's Life

A 21-year-old Soldier stationed at Schofield Barracks, Hawaii, died in a swimming mishap 31 May 2019 in Kailua Bay, Oahu, Hawaii, at 1700 local. The Soldier was swimming with two civilians when witnesses noted the swimmers were in distress. Surfers attempted to help the swimmers, but they were unable to locate the Soldier. His body was recovered three days later.
