ACV Mishap Claims One Soldier's Life

A Soldier assigned to the Nevada Army National Guard died in an Army combat vehicle mishap 4 June 2019 at the National Training Center, Fort Irwin, California, at 2330 local. The Soldier was serving as the tank commander in an M1A1 Abrams during a night movement when the vehicle overturned into a wadi.
