PMV-2 Mishap Claims One Soldier's Life

A 21-year-old Private First Class assigned to Fort Bliss, Texas, died in a PMV-2 mishap 22 September 2019 in El Paso, Texas, at 1659 local. The Soldier was attempting to turn left into a shopping facility when his motorcycle collided with another vehicle. He and his civilian passenger were pronounced dead at the scene. The Soldier had completed the Motorcycle Safety Foundation's Basic *RiderCourse*. Personal protective equipment use is unknown at this time. The mishap is under investigation.
