PMV-2 Mishap Claims One Soldier's Life

A 26-year-old Staff Sergeant assigned to Tampa, Florida, died in a PMV-2 mishap 9 November 2019 in Glade County, Florida, at 1545 local. The Soldier was operating a motorcycle in a group of four riders when he attempted to make a U-turn in the left lane. One of the civilian riders sped up to catch the Soldier and they collided.

Both riders died at the scene. The Soldier had completed all Army-required motorcycle training, but was not wearing any personal protective equipment other than boots. The mishap is under investigation.
