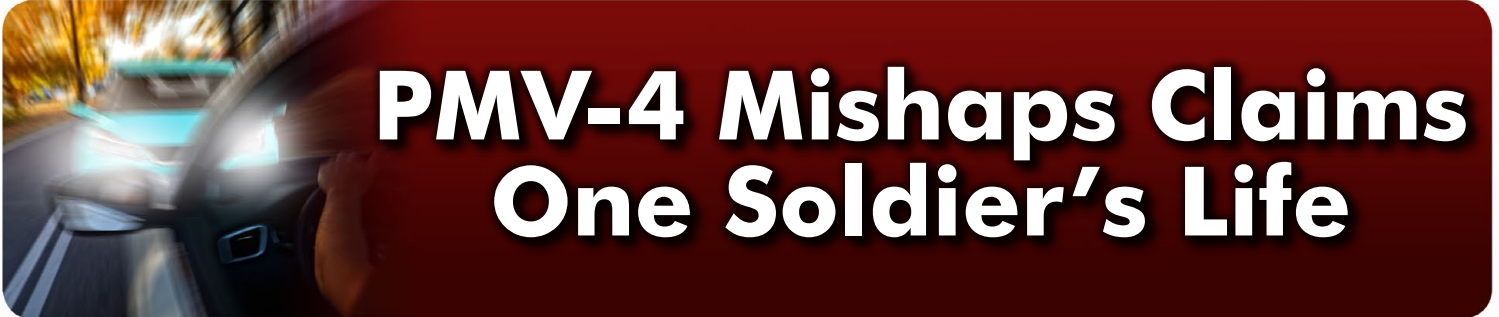

## PMV-4 Mishaps Claims One Soldier's Life

A 19-year-old Private First Class assigned to Fort Riley, Kansas, died in a PMV-4 mishap 15 December 2019 in Texhoma, Texas, at 0515 local. The Soldier was attempting to pass a semi-truck when he collided with an oncoming vehicle. He was pronounced dead at the scene. The civilian passenger in the other vehicle also died, and the driver suffered non-fatal injuries. The Soldier's seat belt and alcohol use are unknown at this time. The mishap is under investigation. This was the fourth PMV-4 mishap in FY20.
